

As scary as Halloween may seem, do not let this spooky holiday keep you and your loved ones from enjoying your evening. There are things we can do to ensure that everyone has a safe and fun Halloween. Here are some safety tips to follow for Halloween!

DRESSING SAFE

- Plan costumes that are reflective and bright. Add reflective tape to the costume or trick-or-treat bags for greater visibility.
- Consider non-toxic makeup or decorative hats to prevent masks from blocking eyesight. Look for costumes that indicate they are flame-resistant.
- Avoid decorative contact lenses without an eye examination. Decorative contact lenses are dangerous and can cause pain, inflammation, serious eye disorders, and infections, which may lead to permanent vision loss.

HOME SAFE HOME

- Remove any lawn decorations, bikes, toys, or anything else from the porch and front yard to prevent anyone from tripping when approaching the lawn.
- Replace any burned-out lightbulbs to improve visibility for trick-or-treaters.
- Restrain any pets so they do not jump on or bite any trick-or-treaters.

ON THE TRICK-OR-TREAT TRAIL

- Always accompany young children while trick-or-treating. Carry flashlights with fresh batteries.
- Never enter a home or vehicle for treats.
- Remain on well-lit streets and stay on the sidewalk.
- Never cut across yards or use alleys.
 - Never assume the right of way, motorists may not be able to see trick-or-treaters. Do not assume because one stops, others will.


